- · We have a limited offer of services for those in the process of assessment for autism.

### How do we currently support?

Due to the COVID-19 outbreak we have made some changes to how we support young people and their families:

- Referrals can continue to be made to us for support
- We will update you with the latest information and guidance from the government and the NHS and how we are now working
- We will do our initial clinic appointments with you over the telephone instead of face to face
- We will continue to book dates for future workshops, we will be in touch with you before the start date to tell you if it is going ahead
- We can deliver our workshop content to you over the phone if you are booked on a workshop that can't go ahead. We will send out resources, and usually book 2 sessions with you over the phone. You can still attend a future workshop face to face.
- We can send resources to you, or signpost you to resources on the internet to support you whilst we can't see you face to face
- We can listen to you and will support you the best we can in this situation
- We can offer general advice over the telephone whilst we can't see you face to face
- We may be able to complete some of our PBS behaviour work with you- we will discuss this on an individual basis And you can help...
